Have good listening skills, good manners, respect everyone, treat everyone the same.

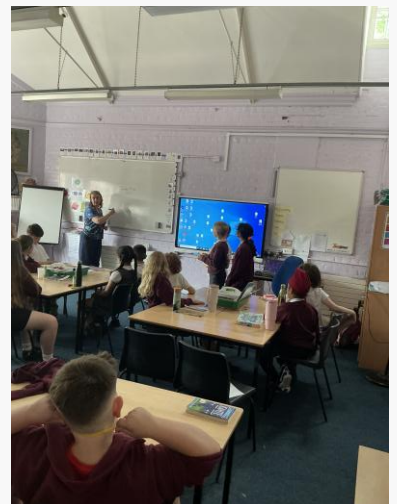


Being a student researcher (feelings)..
