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## What does a student researcher do (role)?

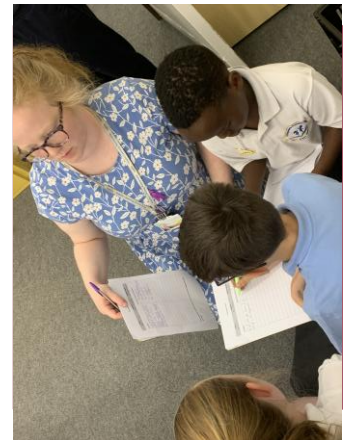


A student researcher is a voice for pupils.

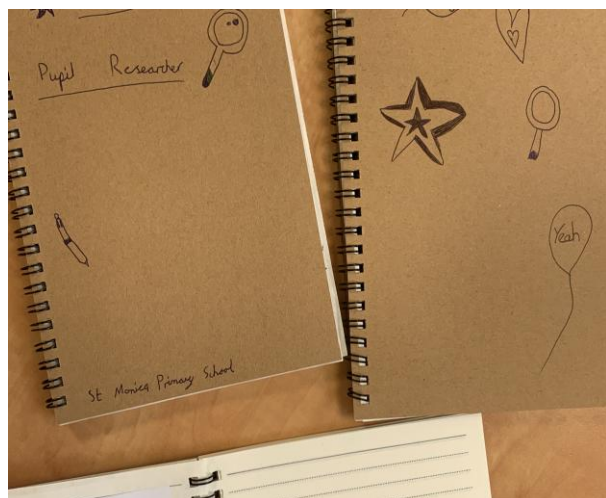
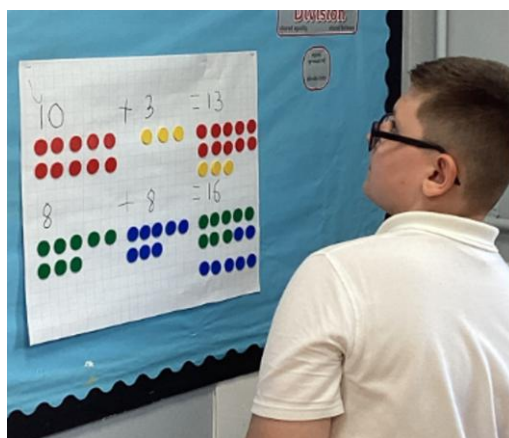
